PHASE ONE

Session 1 – Monday, February 27, 2017 (4pm – 6pm)

Chapters 4 & 5 - Work through workbook, Review DVD's, Q & A

Rules and Regulations

Student Licenses:

Once Driving lessons commence students must present their paper license at the beginning of every driving lesson. If the student's license is not present at this time the lesson will not be held. Make up lessons will only be made if the instructor has time, and the student shows interest in completing.
